Report of Treasurer

The Board finished the examination of the report of the County Treasurer with the following result as adopted by the Board:

"The Treasurer, A. L. Cox submitted his annual report which was carefully examined by the Board. They found him properly charged with the balance received from his predecessor J. C. Wallin \$96,011⁰⁰ with the tax roll of 1892, and all moneys coming into his hands during the year, and which they verified as far as possible by the records of the Clerk. They also found vouchers for all money paid out, and the cash and bonds on hand to agree with the amounts as shown by the statement. Cash in Bonds \$23,128⁰⁰, in N. Y. Bond Agency \$20⁰⁰, in Treasurer's Vault \$631⁰⁰, Bonds \$48,695⁰⁰. This report covers the time from Oct 11, 1892 to Oct 23rd 1893, inclusive.
