The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

In the matter of a Road

petitioned for by J. Bruce & others }

On the 23rd day of December 1893, a Road Petition signed by J. Bruce and 18 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kans. praying for the vacation of a certain road described as follows: "That part of Road No. 51, located in the SW^{1/4} of section 20, T. 4. R. 20. S. 20. N. 20. said portion to be relocated upon a section line between S. 20th and SW^{1/4} of said section 20." also to extend said Road 51 from its junction with the old Route 72 road near centre of section 29 to meet Route 72 road as now located; along section line between section 29 and 32, T. 14. Range 20. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by J. Bruce as principal and H. C. Brueger and W. L. Thompson as sureties in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view.

Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, It was ordered that J. A. Rodgers, W. H. Gill and A. J. Woods be appointed viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

In the matter of a road

petitioned for by Geo. T. Felt & others }

On the 23rd day of December 1893, a Road Petition signed by Geo. T. Felt and 19 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas, praying for the vacation of a certain road described as follows: "Recorded in Road Book as Road No. 367, and located as follows: Begin at a sec corner between sections 17 and 20, T. 14. Range 20. thence N. 70° 10' E. thence North 40° 00' chs on a sec line to old road." Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by Geo. T. Felt as principal and A. B. Tuttle and J. A. Duff as sureties in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, It was ordered that J. A. Rodgers, W. H. Gill and A. J. Woods be appointed viewers on the proposed road and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice and proceed to
