On the 3rd day of December 1893, a Road Petition signed by B.S. Petzold and 14 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commrs of Douglas County, Kansas, praying for the re-location of a certain road described as follows: Tract: Commencing at a point on the East line of Section 13, Twp 13, Range 18, West about rods from the NE corner of said section and running in a South Westerly direction to a point on the West line of the NE¹/₄ of said section and about rods from the North line of said section, and re-locate above described road parallel to its former location, commencing at the East line of the above named section and running South 50 feet, thence in a South Westerly direction parallel to the above named road to the West line of NE¹/₄ of above named section, thence N 50 feet to where said road crosses W line of NE¹/₄ Sec 13, T. 13, R. 18. Said Petition was accompanied with a bond signed by B.S. Petzold as principal and Cassin Smith and Chas. Petzold as sureties in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view, whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that Frank Walter, Mike Holm and J.A. Kelly be appointed Viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

On the 2nd day of January 1894, a Road Petition signed by M.L. Kennedy and 20 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commrs of Douglas County, Kansas, praying for the vacation of a certain road described as follows: Beginning at the SE corner of the NE¹/₄ of Sec 24, T. 13, R. 12, thence running North or near section line one mile to intersection of State road running East & West. Said Petition was accompanied with a bond signed by M.L. Kennedy as principal and D.T. Skole and J.C. Morse as sureties in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view, whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that W.D. Anderson and W.T. Bell be appointed Viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report
