On the 2nd day of Jan'y 1894, a Road Petition signed by Lemard Dec and 64 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County praying for the location of a certain road described as follows: Beginning at the 1/4 Sec corner on Section line dividing Section No 4 and Sec No 9 Township 13 Range 18. on road 46 thence South on line dividing the NE 1/4 & NW 1/4 of said Sec 9 to Deer creek, thence crossing said creek at most available place and following the foot of bluff first North Easterly to turn in point of bluff, thence North Westerly by most direct and practicable route to State road at Belvoir Station.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by Lemard Dec as principal and Christian W. Kuhnle and F. A. Dwyer as sureties in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said road. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered, that James Fitzpatrick, William Young and Henry Danner be appointed viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
