In the matter of a Road
Petition for by M. W. Vanhook et al

On the 9th day of Jan'y 1894, a Road Petition signed by M. W. Vanhook and 37 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commis of Douglas Co. Kas. praying for the vacation of a certain road described as follows: "One mile of road running South, com at the NW cor of Sec 24, T. 18. R. 18. now being and located along West side of said section, as to a point where it intersects road running East." Said Petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by Martha Myers and J. B. B. as sureties in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said road, whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that P. A. Dolbe, H. F. Watts and Will Schaeffer be appointed Viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning, on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

Compromise of Taxes

In the matter of suit of W. W. Cookins vs Board of Commissioners of Douglas County to compel the Board to refund certain taxes upon School land. This coming on for hearing before said Board, the same was duly compromised with said W. W. Cookins for the sum of \$400, and the said Cookins in consideration of said sum fully discharges the said Board of Commissioners from all liability on account of said taxes. And the said Cookins hereby agrees to dismiss his suit, to wit: No. 5504 against said Board of County Commissioners at his cost and the same is now hereby dismissed with prejudice to said Plaintiff's costs.
