Resolution to compromise of }
D. F. & L. H. Taxes }

The D. F. & L. H. Co. submitted the following proposition:
"If Douglas Co. will allow our Company to pay at once without penalty one half of the taxes as now charged upon the lands of Douglas Co. for the year 1893, the second half to be paid by June 20th upon the same basis, our company protesting against the payment of that portion which we consider excessive, we will at once make payment of first half."

On motion the proposition was unanimously rejected.
