A petition from This Breeze asking to be allowed to redeem 10¹/₂ acres in NW 1/4 Sec 20 T. 4 S. R. 20. from County tax sale of 1893. upon payment of amount of original sale without interest or costs of redemption was presented to the Board and on motion granted.

The Board having examined and accepted the bridge across the Wakarusa at Rock Ford the Chairman order was instructed to issue scrip to Farnsworth & Blodgett in payment of same.

Thomas Breeze et al }

The aforesaid petition of Thomas Breeze et al as recorded in Comm's Record 7 page 568 being under consideration the following action thereon was had by the Board of County Commissioners to-wit: Upon due consideration no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned and believing the same to be of public utility it is ordered that the viewers report of view and report and plat of survey be adopted, as follows viz: Re-locate. Begin at center & corner of sec 20 T. 4 S. R. 20. thence Var 10° E. South on 1/4 sec line 27 chains to intersection of old road. "Variation". Begin as above thence S 67° W 150 chs to angle stake. S 66 W 90 chs to angle stake S 17° E 200 chs to angle stake. S 18° E 80 chs to angle stake. S 17° E 100 chs to angle stake in the 1/4 sec line of said sec 20 T. 4 S. R. 20. "Extension". Begin at the center 1/4 of sec 29 T. 4 S. R. 20. thence Var 10° E. North on 1/4 sec line 15 chains to a stake in North boundary of old Santa Fe road, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith. Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and Plat as Road No. - and the Trustee of Palmyra Township be notified to cause the same to be opened 40 feet wide.
