Bridge 3

On motion it was ordered that an appropriation of \$145⁰⁰ be made for the filling of Eudora bridge across Kansas river. On motion an appropriation of \$294⁷⁵ was made to pay for drawing filling, hauling stone and labor for the bridge over Kansas river at Eudora.

On motion the Board set Tuesday April 17th 1894. as the day for hearing the Barber bridge petition.

Interest on Bank Balances 3

The Banks of Lawrence submitted a proposition to the Board offering to pay one per cent on daily balances of County deposits after May 1st 1894. On motion the Board accepted the proposition with the proviso that each bank furnish a check book lithographed for use of County Treasurer.
