

In Burroughs vs. Norton, 29th Kansas, page 196, the Supreme Court in an opinion rendered by Judge Valentine, says:

"The limitation of \$100 contained in the proviso to amend Sec. 13 of the act relating to counties and county officers, which relates to the compensation of members of the board of county commissioners, does not include pay for the service of such members while attending meetings to equalize assessments, to levy taxes, or to canvass the returns of elections, and hence the members of the board of county commissioners, after receiving \$100 as compensation for services rendered in attending the regular and special meetings of the board, provided for in the body of said Sec. 13, may receive further compensation for services rendered in attending meetings to equalize assessments, to levy taxes, and to canvass returns of elections." To limit the entire compensation of the members.

The court in its opinion in the above named case, in construing Sec. 13 above mentioned, further says: "This section, it will be perceived, provides for regular meetings of the county board to be held on the first Mondays of January, July and October, and on the first Monday after the first Tuesday in April, and provides for special meetings to be held on the call of the chairman at the request of two members of the board. And no other regular or special meetings are provided for by said section. The proviso states: 'That the pay for such service, including all regular and special meetings, shall never exceed the sum of \$100 to each commissioner any one year.' Now, the words 'such service' unquestionably mean the service performed at the regular and special meetings provided for in the body of the section. And further state: 'Besides, there are no meetings of the board which can be properly termed regular or special meetings, except such as provided for in the body of said section.'
