On the 12th day of May 1894 a Road Petition signed by John Stockner and 18 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County. Res. praying for the location and vacation of a certain road described as follows. tract: Beginning on the North line of Sec 6, T. 15. R. 19, where the 1/2 sec line intersects said North line, thence running South on said 1/2 sec line of Sec 6 and 7, two (2) miles to intersect road on South line of section 7. Vacate County road along the range line between Ranges 18 and 19, along the West line of sections 6 and 7, Township 15, Range 19, 2 miles. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by John Stockner as principal, and H. N. Oliver and Ch. Kusbaum as sureties in the sum of all expenses and
