On the 2nd day of July 1894 a Road Petition signed by D. N. Shall and 17 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kas. praying for the location of a road described as follows: Beginning at the South West corner of the 11. Range 17. Town 13. and running East one mile, and to be 40 feet wide." Said petition was accompanied by a bond signed by D. N. Shall as principal, and M. S. Hinds and G. Luffer as sureties, in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view, whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered that Albert Walter, Chris Balmaier and Elias Lake be appointed Viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the Co Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice, and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing, and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
