

Lawrence, Kansas. July 9th. (cont^d)

Upon due consideration and no legal objections having been offered against the establishment of said road, hereinafter mentioned, and believing the same to be of public utility, it is ordered that the Viewers report of View and report and plat of survey be adopted as follows: begin at the corner between Sec 4 and 9 T. 13. R. 18. Thence N. 7° E. South 21.00 chs. to bank of creek. S 27° E. 4.47. South bank of creek. S 8° E. 282 angle stake. S 51° E. 2.85 W. Oak 15'. S 64° E. 8.32. W. Oak 15'. S 74° E. 2.76. W. Oak 10'. S 65° E. 3.07 W. Oak 15'. S 55° E. 3.70. S. Oak 10'. S 31° E. 2.22. S. Elm 6'. S 11° W. 3.52 angle stake. S 38° W. 11.01 to angle stake. S 54° W. 18.73. stake. S 43° W. 3.92. angle stake. S 36° W. 14.24 angle stake. S 61° W. 2.84 angle stake. S 2° W. 5.12 to angle stake 33 links S. of Sec line S 32° W. 12.73. to angle stake. S 10° W. 22.07 to angle stake. S 1° E. 5.97 to intersection of State Road, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith. Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and plat as Road No. - and the Trustee of Clinton Twp be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel 40 feet wide. Damages allowed: Jacob Muger \$100. H. A. Cummings \$100.

Appropriation for
