The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

In relation to personal property
assessment of M. J. Babcock }

In the above case the Board on motion ordered the County Clerk to place upon the tax roll of 1894 in Lawrence Twp an assessment of \$5.000 personal property against Martha J. Babcock. The foregoing assessment being made upon a valuation of \$15.000 on the note or evidence of indebtedness given by the heirs of Orville Babcock deceased to the said Martha J. Babcock, and being the same note as shown on Comm'r Record "F" page 607.

Sale of old lumber }

On motion the Board authorized Comm'r Hughes to sell the old flooring of the Lawrence bridge at 50 cts per hundred feet, also the first quality of pine joists @ 1st per 100 ft. 2nd quality @ 75^{cts}. Board instructed clerk to advertise sale of said lumber.

Janitor Court House. }

On motion the Board employed Anderson Morris as janitor at the Court House for the period of one month, begin July 13, 1894, @ \$25⁰⁰ per month. if services are satisfactory he to be continued as such janitor.

Bill of Kansas Water & Light Co. }

Upon the advice of the County the Board on motion sent back the bill presented by the Kansas Water & Light Co. for water used in sink, animal & closet from July 1st 1894 to July 12/94 = 20^{cts}. with instructions to present same to the City.

On motion the Board appointed This Dec as Bridge Comm'r of the Still bridge, now building.
