The Board of County Commissioners met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

Appropriation for superstructure of O'Sullivan bridge

On motion the Board appropriated the sum of \$100.00 for superstructure of O'Sullivan bridge.

Tax proposition of A. R. Greene

A petition from A. R. Greene offering the sum of \$5.00 in full of all tax claims for a tax deed upon Lots 22 & 23 Block 12 City of Leavenworth, was presented to the Board and on motion accepted.

In the matter of a Road Petition of G. J. Balmmaier

On the 1st day of October 1894, a Road Petition signed by G. J. Balmmaier and 25 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, praying for the location of a certain road described as follows: Town 1: Beginning at a point 40 ft N of the NE cor of N 8th Sec 16 Twp 12 R. 18. Thence S 80 ft. 180 ft. S 80 ft. to a point 40 ft S of N 8th of N 8th of Sec 16. Twp 12 R. 18. Also vacate: Begin at a point 20 ft W of NE cor of N 8th Sec 16 Twp 12 R. 18. Thence S to a point 20 ft S of the SE cor of N 8th of N 8th Sec 16 Twp 12 R. 18.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by G. J. Balmmaier as principal and C. F. Balmmaier as surety in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that John Bence, Wm. Shree and E. L. Taylor be appointed viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the Cadmusys at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of the proceedings to the County Board.

The Board examined and allowed claims against the County and on motion
