Appropriation Grant Township

The Board on motion appropriated the sum of \$400.00 for construction of drain in Grant Township.

In the matter of a road 3
petitioned for by J. N. Stull 3

The aforesaid petition of J. N. Stull as recorded in Comptroller's Record "T" page 610 being under consideration, the following action thereon was had by the Board of County Commissioners: Upon due consideration no legal objection having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned, and believing the same to be of public utility it is hereby ordered that the viewers report of view and report and plat of survey be adopted as follows: Begin at the South West corner of Sec 11, Town 13, North Range 17 East, thence Var $8^{\circ} 45'$ E, East in line between Secs 11 & 14 - 80.00 chains to corner to Secs 11, 12, 13 & 14 and intersection of road running North & South, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith. Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and plat as Road No - and the Trustees of Lawrence Township be notified to cause the same to be opened for the Public Travel 40 feet wide.
