The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kans. met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

Petition for release of
Jas Dennis from County Jail

A petition signed by L. W. Hindman et al. asking for the release of James Dennis from the County Jail. He having been in jail since Oct 10/94 under a sentence of 30 days, and that he has unable to pay the costs amounting to \$6⁰⁰. On motion the petition was granted by the Board & he was ordered discharged.

Repairs at County Jail

On motion the Board authorized the Sheriff to have Mr. Kimball make necessary repairs at County Jail (said repairs being specified in Prob. Judge & County's last report).

Order Blanks for Process of Poor

On motion the Clerk was instructed to have 1000 paper order blanks printed for use of the different Township Poor Overseers, said bills to be 6 x 6 inches in size.

Treas^r instructed to
cancel same

On motion the Clerk was instructed to issue order to County Treasurer to cancel \$2,800⁰⁰ of the \$4,000 of poor property assessed in 1894 to L. W. Hindman as assignee of W. H. Rudolph's def. said \$4,000. being an erroneous & an excessive assessment upon the said def. of W. H. Rudolph.

In the matter of a Road Returned for
by Henry Hiett et al

On the 10th day of January 1895, a Road Petition signed by Henry Hiett and 15 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kans. praying for the Location of a certain road described as follows. To wit: Beginning at the S.E. corner of Twin Mound school lot thence N on W side of a stone fence on or about 70 rods to intersect a County road running E & W on a line of Sec 1, T. 2, R. 17. And to vacate road now running East from S.E. corner of said school lot some 50 rods. thence N to said County road.

Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by Henry Hiett as principal and J. F. Badley & J. A. Fehrling as surety in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered that D. W. D. C. W. D. and C. W. D. be appointed Viewers
