In relation to the proposition of Geo. Stuart to purchase of certain lots in Baldwin sold for taxes, the Board instructed the Clerk to notify said Stuart that the County will accept \$5⁰⁰ to satisfy County's interest in same.

Proposition of W. W. Junkins }
to redeem lots in Baldwin }

The Board received a proposition from W. W. Junkins offering the sum of \$5⁰⁰ for a redemption receipt from the tax sales of 1892-1893-94 on S. O. plat of Lots 10 and 11 Meigs, said sum to cover all costs & expenses of redemption. On motion the Board accepted said proposition.

Road Petitioned for by }
John Finerty and 18 others }

On the 27th day of December 1894 a Road Petition signed by John Finerty and 18 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas, praying for the location of a certain road described as follows, to wit: the place of beginning is at the NW^{1/4} of Sec 18, Town 15, Range 21, and its termination at a point directly West one mile to intersect N & S County road on East line of Sec 11, T. 15, R. 21. Said Petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law, signed by John Finerty as principal and Frank Van Treco as surety, in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it was ordered that John Black, Bud Battell and W. S. Boyd be appointed Viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
