On the 14th day of January 1895, a Road Petition signed by W. J. Sanders and 15 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commis of Douglas Co. Kans. praying for the location of a certain road described as follows: "To wit: Beginning 40 rods due North of corner stone between Secs 2 and 3, thence due North on said line to grave yard, thence East 10 rods, thence North 20 rods to intersect public highway." Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by W. J. Sanders as principal and C. W. High & W. A. Davis as sureties in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said road. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered that J. L. Hardlager, D. F. Huston and W. W. Williams be appointed viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning, on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

The Board on motion decided to allow the sum of \$110.00 on the claim of the Kansas Water & Light Co. for \$113.00 for water furnished the County Jail. the official claim being balance due said Co for quarter ending Sep 30/94, and all of quarter ending Dec 31/94.
