Lake View Drain }

The following resolution was introduced and on motion
adopted by the Board: Whereas: It appearing to the satisfaction of
the Board of County Commis of Douglas County, that it will be conducive
to the public health and the benefit of the public highways running across
Lake View in Douglas County, and whereas said Board has been petitioned
according to law by H. B. Rogers to construct a spur from a main hole
in a drain running from Baldwin's Branch to Lake View, commencing at a
main hole in said drain said spur to run from said main hole to said
Baldwin Branch, all of said spur being in Douglas County.

Be it resolved: That the County of Douglas by its County Commis in
regular session do hereby appropriate the sum of Four hundred dollars
to construct and build a drain or spur from a certain drain as aforesaid
as follows. First: Commencing at a main hole in the drain running
from mud creek or Baldwin's Branch into the lake at or near the Lake
View shooting and fishing club house, said lake known as Lake View, and
said drain which said main hole is situated constructed by said Lake
View Shooting and Fishing club, and said spur commencing at said main hole
as aforesaid and running in a North Easterly direction about Eight hundred
and twenty eight feet into mud creek commonly known as Baldwin's Branch.
said appropriation to be made on this condition, that the said Lake View
Shooting and Fishing club furnish superintendent and report to the Board of County
Commissioners the condition of said spur and report the same when it is out
of order, and relieve the County from any and all liability, damages or
otherwise for the construction of the same, and Provided further that said
club or any other party or parties shall furnish sufficient funds in
addition to the said four hundred dollars to complete said spur, and
Provided further that said club shall enter into a written agreement contract
to and with the aforesaid County to perform all the conditions hereuntofore
set forth, said tubing to be used in said drain to be fifteen inches in
diameter, and said payment of four hundred dollars to be made after
the said contract between the said club & Board of County Commissioners is
signed, and said spur or drain is completed and approved by the Board
of County Commissioners and the County Surveyor of Douglas County, all the
work done on said drain to be done under the superintendence of the
County Surveyor.

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
