The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

In relation to petition for
release of James Gross }

A petition having been presented to the Board asking that James Gross Jr (convicted of violating the prohibitory law) be released from jail upon payment of one half the costs in his case (\$32⁰⁰) and that the price of \$100⁰⁰ imposed on said Gross be remitted.

On motion it was ordered to release said Gross on condition that he pay to the Sheriff of Douglas Co to apply on the costs of said case the sum of \$32⁰⁰. This resolution does not release the said Gross from imprisonment on his failure to pay balance of judgment for costs, and further provided that the said Gross leaves the City of Lawrence by March 12th 1895 and remains away. If said Gross does not leave the City by that time this order will be null and void, and said Gross shall be subject to arrest and imprisonment for balance of said costs.
