

Lawrence. Kans. April 11th 1895.

The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

Present: Mr. S. Winter, Chairman.

D. F. Hughes, Geo. B. F. Hookinson and the County Clerk.

In the matter of a road petitioned for by W. B. Bristow et al

The aforesaid petition of W. B. Bristow as recorded in Comm's Record "4" page 7 being under consideration the following action thereon was had by the Board of County Commissioners. To wit: Upon due consideration no legal objection having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned and believing the same to be of public utility it is ordered, that the viewers report of view and report and plat of survey be adopted as follows: Beginning at Nelsons Sec 9, T. 15. N. R. 20 E. the E. on N line Sec 9. 57.07 chains to the center line of North St. Baldwin City. from this point a street 40 feet wide extends E to the N. B. on Sec 9. and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith. full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and Plat as Road No. - and the Trustee of Saline Township is notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel 40 feet wide. 20 feet on either side of the N line of Sec 9. T. 15. N. R. 20 E.

Tracing Examiners

The Board on motion appointed W. H. Gill and J. L. Butcher as tracing examiners for the ensuing quarter.

Appropriation to the Harry Gigg T. Reform school to inform a. l. s.

On motion the Board appropriated the sum of twenty-five dollars to the Harry Gigg T. Reform school.

In the matter of a road petitioned for by J. H. Hume et al

On the 10th day of April 1895, a Road Petition signed by James Hume and 21 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County Kansas. praying for the location of a certain road described as follows. Tract: Beginning at the N. B. on Sec 3. T. 12. N. R. 19. the W along N line of said Sec 3 about one mile to East of land & across owned by J. Hume. the following N line of said & across tract to point where N line of said tract intersects N line of Sec 4. the W along N line of Sec 4 about 20 rods to intersect county road running N & S through center of said & out 33. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by James Hume as principal and J. L. Butcher as surety in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view. Whereupon said Board was adjourned.
