Sullivan as sureties, in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered that John Barker, J. A. Hallerman & Marshall Solder be appointed Viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.
