Vacation of part of
Endora City

The following resolutions in relation to vacation of Tyler Place
and a part of Endora City were introduced and on motion adopted:
"Whereas the streets and alleys in the town of Endora lying South
of 12th St except C and E and 19th Sts were by act of the Legislature
of 1889 vacated the Township assessor of Endora Twp is hereby
authorized and directed to describe on the assessment roll of 1895
the land embraced in said vacation by meter and bounds, and to
assess the same in the names of the respective owners thereof as
land in Endora Township."

Tyler Place

"Whereas Tyler Place in Wakarusa Township was by act of the Leg-
islature of 1895 vacated the assessor of Wakarusa Twp is hereby
authorized and directed to describe the same upon the assessment
roll of 1895 by meter and bounds and assess the same in the
names of the respective owners thereof."

Appropriation for bridge
across Little Wakarusa

The Board on motion appropriated the sum of \$400
or as much thereof as may be necessary to build bridge across
the little Wakarusa creek on road running between Sections 26 and 32
Township 13, Range 26, and the chairman and clerk of the Board are
authorized to issue scrip in payment of same upon its completion
and acceptance by the Board.

Remittance of fine of
Ed Prather

On motion the Board remitted the fine against Ed Prather
