The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County
Kans. met at the office of the County Clerk pursuant to
law, as a Board of Equalization.

After considering some of the
general property assessments the Board adjourned as a
Board of Equalization and resumed as the Board of County
Commissioners in special session.

In relation to release of
John Franklin from the County Jail }

The following resolution in relation to
the release of John Franklin from the County Jail was introduced:
"Whereas John Franklin whose term of imprisonment in
the Douglas County jail in conviction for violation of the Prohibitory
law expired on May 13th 1895. and whereas a fine of \$300 and
the costs of the conviction remain unpaid. Now therefore be it
resolved that on condition the said John Franklin pay all the costs
of this action and that said John Franklin leave Douglas County at
once and remain out of the State of Kansas until he pay the said
fine of \$300. The said John Franklin shall return before payment of said
fine. The Sheriff of Douglas County shall commit the said John Franklin
to the said jail under the commitment and judgment in the case of
the State of Kansas vs John Franklin, and this order shall not discharge
in any court said fine. If said Franklin pay the said costs and
agree and comply with the above conditions he may be released
from custody of the Sheriff." Upon motion the resolution was
adopted by the following vote: Yeas. Winter and Hughes. Nays
Hookinson. The adoption of above resolution was recommended by the County Attorney.
