Now therefore on condition said auction shall pay in costs \$26.⁰⁰, and shall pay ^{into the County Treasury} the sum of \$3.⁰⁰ per month for the term of one year from this date, he may be released from the custody of the sheriff. This order not to discharge said costs unless complied with, but said defendant may be committed if not complied with. The above resolution was recommended for adoption by the County attorney. On motion the Board adopted the resolution and which said release to take effect on and after the payment of \$26.⁰⁰ as aforesaid.
