

Lawrence Kans. June 6th 1895.

The Board of Equalization of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

Present: Mr. S. Dieter, Chairman.
D. J. Hughes and B. F. Hollium, and the County Clerk.

On motion the Board ordered the personal property of B. F. Frederick of Clinton Twp to be raised from \$780 to \$1200. The assessment in balance of amount of credits over and above amount paid up in 1894 being doubled and the amount of mortgages for 1895 being doubly assessed in account of note being reported fully in 1894. The above order was made upon the recommendation of the Trustees of Clinton Township.

On motion the Board adjourned as a Board of Equalization and resumed as a Board of County Commissioners in special session.
