

Lawrence, Kansas. June 8th 1895.

The Court Board of Equalization met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

Present: M. S. Winter, Chairman.
J. F. Hughes, B. F. Haslinson and the County Clerk.

On motion the personal property assessment of the Big Springs Creamery Co in Leamington Twp was lowered from \$500⁰⁰ to \$200⁰⁰.

The Board on motion adjourned as a Board of Equalization and convened as a Board of County Commissioners in special session. The following resolution was introduced by Comm^r Hughes and on motion adopted:

Whereas, Ed Brown who was at the July term of the District Court of this County sentenced to the County Jail of this County for a term of 90 days and to pay the costs of prosecution, and the term of his imprisonment has expired and the costs are still unpaid, be it resolved - that said Ed Brown be released from the said jail at once on condition that he pay to the Sheriff of Douglas County, to apply on said costs the sum of two dollars \$2⁰⁰ per week until the full amount of said costs are paid. That in case he neglects or refuses to pay said sums of money as herein stipulated this release shall be null and void.

On motion the Board adjourned to meet as a Board of Equalization on June 10th 1895.
