The County Board of Equalization met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.

Present: M. S. Winter, Chairman.
D. F. Hughes and B. F. Hickinson and the County Clerk.

On motion reductions were made in personal property valuations in Endora Township as follows:

Aug Gabriel assessment reduced from 345⁰⁰ to 125⁰⁰ by allowance of exempt
H. Gabriel allowed exemption of 200⁰⁰ and his assessment of 185⁰⁰
was taken from the rolls.

On motion the personal property assessment of A. Griffin of Endora Twp was raised from 50⁰⁰ to 125⁰⁰, on recommendation of trustee.

The Board adjourned and convened as a Board of County Commissioners in special session.

In relation to vacation
of streets & alleys in Endora City

The following amendment of the resolution passed by the Board April 17, 1895, was introduced and on motion adopted:

"The Resolution passed by this Board found on page 26 of Commis Board Book 'G', in reference to the streets and alleys in the town of Endora and authorizing the Township Assessor to assess said real estate not as town property, said resolution is now by this Board reconsidered and is hereby declared null and void, and the Township assessors for the year 1895 and thereafter assess said property under the same description as town property, in the same manner as said property was assessed before said Resolution was passed."

On motion the Board adjourned to meet as a Board of Equalization on June 12th, 1895.
