The County Board of Equalization of Douglas County met pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.
Present: M. S. Winter, Chairman.
D. F. Hughes and B. J. Holbrook and the County Clerk.

On motion the assessment of Lot 87 New Hampshire St was ordered taken from the assessment rolls, said property being now the M. E. Parsonage and exempt from taxation.

On motion the Board ordered the assessment of personal property of Martha J. Robert in Walnut St to be raised from \$1,745 to \$5,080. the same being an increase of \$3,335 in amount of credits returned by her for taxation.

On motion the Board adjourned to June 13, 1895.
