 Bert Walker from County Jail }
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The following resolution in regard to release of
 Bert Walker from County Jail was introduced and on motion adopted:

"Whereas heretofore Bert Walker was convicted of violation
 of the prohibiting law, said conviction being made in Justice Cooper's
 Court, and the term of his sentence has expired, and whereas said
 Bert Walker has no money to pay his fine and costs, Resolved
 that said Bert Walker be released from the County Jail on condition
 that he pay to the Sheriff of Douglas County the sum of \$1.00 per week
 until the balance of costs are paid. Otherwise this resolution to be
 of no effect."

Resolution in relation to release of
 of Peter Faggard from County Jail }

a petition having been presented to the Board
 asking for the release of Peter Faggard from the County Jail, the following
 resolution was introduced and on motion adopted:

"Whereas Peter Faggard was in Justice Christie's Court
 convicted of selling intoxicating liquor contrary to law, and the
 term of his imprisonment has long since expired, and whereas
 the said Peter Faggard has shown to this Board that he has not money
 to pay his fine and costs, Be it Resolved that the said Peter
 Faggard be released from the County Jail on condition that he pay
 the costs taxed against him within three months from the date of
 this resolution, and unless said costs are paid this resolution to
 be null and void unless otherwise ordered by this Board."
