1 Dedication of land for road 3
by F. Breithaupt }

The following dedication of land for a public
road was received and accepted by the Board:

For the consideration of "40" to me in land paid I hereby
dedicate to the County of Douglas, State of Kansas, for the purpose of
a public highway the following described land in the County of Douglas
State of Kansas, to-wit: Being a strip of land 40 feet wide, 20 feet on each side
of center line, said center line runs at a point 6th chain south of the NE
corner of Sec 22, T. 14. N. 21. E. S. 27° 35' West 151 chains, thence N 7° 20'
W 758 chains, thence S 32° 45' E 308 chains to see line containing 6th
acres according to plat and survey on file in office of County Clerk.
In case said road along the above route should ever be abandoned as a
County road the above land to revert to the original owner.
