The aforesaid road petition of J. Finerty et al
coming up the day for a hearing as per postponement from
July 2nd the parties interested were given a hearing, and after
due consideration the Board on motion continued the hearing to

Re-appointment of
Bridge Watchman

On motion the Board re-appointed W. G. Fearing as
watchman of the Lawrence bridge for the ensuing year.

Appropriation for
Normal Institute

On motion the Board appropriated the sum of \$500
for Normal Institute work.

The minutes of the Board meetings, from April 12, 1895
to June 13th 1895 inclusive were read and on motion approved.

In the matter of a Road Petition
of Joseph Maichel et al

On the 29th day of April 1895, a Road Petition
signed by Joseph Maichel et al was filed and the day
presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County.
praying for the location of a certain road described as follows. To wit:
Begin at the NE cor of Sec 29, T. 14. R. 18. and at the NW cor of Sec 28,
T. 14. R. 18. thence running 5 m. sec line 1/4 mile, terminating at a point
on the line at SE cor of Sec 32, and at NW cor of Sec 33 T. 14. R. 18. Maria Top.
Said petition was accompanied by a bond as required by law signed
by Joe Maichel as principal and Chas. Weiss as surety in the sum of
all expenses and costs accruing on said view. Whereupon said
bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction
of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with, it
was ordered that P. A. D. Lee, G. J. Harkstoffer and John O'Sullivan be ap-
pointed viewers of the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction
with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning, on the day designated
in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road ac-
cording to law, giving to all parties a hearing and make due return of
their proceedings to the County Board.
