

Lawrence Kans. July 9th (Cont^d)

On the 9th day of May 1895 a Road Petition signed by P.S. Courson and 13 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kans. praying for the location of a certain road described as follows. To-wit: Beginning at the NW^{1/4} of Sec 1 and NE^{1/4} of Sec 2. Twp 17. R 17. Running for one mile terminating on the line at the NW^{1/4} of Sec 1 and NE^{1/4} of Sec 2 Twp 17. R 17. Said road being now 60 feet in width. Petition to reduce to 40 feet. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law, signed by P.S. Courson as principal and M. Dodder as surety in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said road. Whereupon said bond was approved by the Board, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with. It was ordered that Mr. Mettles, E. Jack and W.D. Harding be appointed Viewers on the proposed road, and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning, on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law, giving all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

The Board examined and on motion allowed claims against the County and

on motion adjourned to July 10th 1895.
