Release of J. W. Gurnee from
Official Bond }

Upon request of J. W. Gurnee the Board on motion released him as surety on the official bond of J. A. Stuehraker, Justice of the Peace in Palmyra Twp. and the clerk was instructed to notify said Stuehraker to file a new bond.

Minutes Read 3

The minutes of the meetings of the Board of County Commis. from June 13th to Aug 5th inclusive were read and on motion approved by the Board.

Tax Levy State purposes 3

The levy for State Taxes was received from the State Auditor as follows: Audit called for \$21,750.32. Assessed valuation was increased 11¹/₂% by the State Board of Equalization instead of 25% as first reported. Rail Road property valuation unchanged, making the tax levy for State purposes on R.R. 4¹/₂ mills to which is added 1¹/₂ of a mill to cover the 11¹/₂% increase, making the levy.

Rail Roads = 4¹/₂ mills
All other property = 1¹/₂ mills

On motion the Board adjourned.
