The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met in special session in the office of the County Clerk.

Present: M. S. Winter, Chairman.

D. F. Hughes and B. F. Hoskinson, and the County Clerk.

In the matter of furnishing clothing for J. N. Stoddy, an inmate of the Insane Asylum at Winfield, Kans. on motion Commissioner Hughes was instructed to purchase to the best of articles called for by the Superintendent of said asylum.

Appointment of Grant Burgoyne
Super to Asylum

The Board on motion appointed Grant Burgoyne as Superintendent of the County Asylum for a period of five (5) months commencing Oct 1, 1895, and ending March 31, 1896, at a salary payable as follows; "100" in Jan'y 15, 1896, and "66" in April 15, 1896. Also the sum of "25" per week for lunch given to be paid by County at the same dates.

The above appointment was made to fill vacancy occasioned by the resignation of A. F. Jones former Superintendent.
