The following resolution was introduced and on motion was adopted by the Board: "Whereas it appears from the records of the County Treasurer that certain moneys were collected for the expense of building a certain ditch known as the Cummings ditch and the State ditch in Lawrence and Clinton Twp's. Douglas County, and now stands on the records charged as follows:

Lawrence Ditch fund	= \$41. ⁶⁴
Clinton	= 21. ²⁵

and whereas said expenses were heretofore paid out of the County General fund. Now therefore be it resolved, that the County Treasurer is hereby instructed to transfer said moneys into the County Ditch fund."
