The Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County met
pursuant to adjournment in the office of the County Clerk.
Present: Mr S. Winter, Chairman.
J. T. Hughes and B. F. Fishman, and the County Clerk.

In the matter of a road

petitioned for by J. T. Fisher et al

The aforesaid petition of John Fisher et al as recorded
in Book "G" page 7. (Comm's Record) being under consideration the following
action thereon was had by the Board of Commissioners. First: Upon due
consideration no legal objection having been offered against the es-
tablishment of said road hereinafter mentioned and believing the same
to be of public utility it is ordered, that the viewers report of view
and report and plat of survey be adopted as follows: Beginning at
the N.W. cor of Sec 18, T. 26. N. R. 21. E. S. 1 & 2 W. along sec line between Secs 12 & 13.
T. 26. N. R. 20. S. 27 chains to the corner of Secs 11, 12, 13, 14, which line is the center of
said road as located by said viewers, the road being 40 ft wide, 20 feet on
each side of said section line, and that said road be declared located
and surveyed established as a public highway in accordance therewith, and
record thereof to be made in the County Clerk's Record and plat as road
No. - and the Trustee of Perryman Trp be notified to cause the same to be
opened for the public travel 40 feet wide.

Appropriation for half Creek bridge
