The foregoing petition of James Lane et al as recorded in Commis Record "B" page 19, being under consideration the following action thereon was had by the Board of Commissioners: Upon due consideration no legal objection having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned and believing the same to be of public utility it is ordered, that the viewers report of view and report and plat of survey be adopted as follows: Begin at the NE cor of Sec 36 T13. R19. & West along the N line of said sec 3 & sec 4. 83.46 ch. to a point 3.28 ch W of the NE cor Sec 4 T13. R19. & N 73° W 19.70 ch & S 59° W 11.10 ch to N line of said sec 4. at W along N line of sec 4. 8.85 ch to the E sec cor, said road to be 40 ft wide, 20 ft on either side of above described land, and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith, full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and plat as road No. and the Trustee of Wakearusa Twp be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel 40 feet wide.
