The aforesaid petition of Joseph Maichel et al as recorded in Comm. Record "3" page 44. being under consideration the following action thereon was had by the Board of Commissioners this: Upon due consideration no legal objection having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned, and believing the same to be of public utility it is ordered, that the known report of view and report and plat of survey be adopted as follows: Beginning 20' E of N.E. cor of Sec 27, T. 14. N. 18. & S. parallel to E line of said sec 27 to S line of same. & from N.E. cor of sec 29, along E line of sec 32, T. 14. N. 18. to N.E. cor of same, said road to be 20' wide on either side of above described line; and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith. Full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and plat as Road No. and the trustees of Marion Twp. be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel 40 feet wide. Damages allowed: Hickman \$30. Thibault \$10. P. A. Simmons \$50.
