

Lawrence Kansas January 10th 1896. Contd.

In the matter of a road petitioned
for by Fred Sulzen Et al

The aforesaid petition of Fred Sulzen as recorded in Commissioners Record 'G' page 61 being under consideration the following action thereon was had by the Board of County Commissioners To wit: Upon due consideration, no legal objection having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned and believing the same to be of public utility, it is ordered that the viewers report of view and report and plat of survey be adopted as follows: begin at a point on section line between Secs 33 & 34 T11 R18 E 24th ch north of south line thereof thence N variation 7° 40' E 10th ch to the 1st cor bet Sec 33 & 34 thence N variation 7° 40' E 28th ch to centre of road no 177. 11th ch S of cor to Secs 33, 34, 27 & 28. and that said road be declared located and established as a public highway in accordance therewith full record thereof to be made in the Co road record and plat as road No 512 and the trustee of LeCompton Twp be notified to cause the same to be opened for the public travel forty feet wide
