

Lawrence Kansas January 11th 1896 contd

In the Matter of a road }
petitioned for J. F. Morgan et al }

On the 11th day of January 1896 a road petition signed by J. F. Morgan and 13 others was filed and this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas County, Kansas praying for the location of a certain road between Secs 9 & 12 R 20 Douglas Co. Kansas and Sec 10 T12 R20 Leavenworth Co. Kansas said road to run north and south between the above named Secs 20 feet of petitioned road is at present opened by Leavenworth Co.

Said petition was accompanied with a Bond as required by law suggested by J. F. Morgan as principal and A. A. Green as surety of the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view whereupon said Bond was approved by the Board and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Board that the law had been substantially complied with it was ordered that W. A. Pine, Al. E. Owen and Charles Lait be appointed viewers on proposed road and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and lay out said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

Claims allowed } The Board examined and on motion allowed claims against the County
and on motion adjourned to Jan 13th 1896
