On the 14th day of December 1895 a road petition signed by A. R. Greene and 36 others was filed on this day presented to the Board of County Commissioners of Douglas Co. Kansas, praying for the location of a certain road as follows to wit: beginning at a point on Shamon Ave in Leecompton where the south line of the Santa Fe railroad right of way intersects the same thence east on said line to the old Cemetery thence in a south easterly direction adjoining the right of way of said railroad to the eastern limits of the City thence following the foot of the bluff to an intersection of the Topeka and Lawrence State road near the house of Jimmy Hill. The total length of said proposed road being approximately one and one-half miles. Said petition was accompanied with a bond as required by law signed by H. B. Rogers as agent for A. R. Greene the principal in the sum of all expenses and costs accruing on said view when upon said
