Toppmugh appointed viewers on the proposed location and that they meet in conjunction with the County Surveyor at the place of beginning on the day designated in their notice and proceed to view and locate said road according to law giving to all parties a hearing and make due report of their proceedings to the County Board.

Contract for Rent
of County Offices }

The proposition presented by the Board of County Commissioners to the City Council in relation to the rent of County Offices coming up for final action it was agreed upon by the Board and City Council that Douglas County pay to the City of Lawrence an annual rental of Fourteen Hundred and Fifty dollars \$450⁰⁰ for rooms occupied as County Offices for a term of five years said rental to be paid quarterly the right being reserved to vacate said offices at any time should the County build a Court House and notice being given the City of said removal on which action a motion was made for adoption of same and approved
