The aforesaid petition of J. S. Morgan & Co. as
recorded in Book 9 Page 75 Commissioners record being under
consideration the following action thereon was had by the
Board of Commissioners to wit: Upon due consideration
no legal objection having been offered against the establishment
of said road hereinafter mentioned and believing the same
to be of public utility it is ordered that the Viewers
report of view and report and plat of survey be
adopted as follows: Beginning at the SE cor of S 9 T 25 R 20 E
thence variation 9° 25' 8" north along sec line 65 chains to where
said road bears east as laid out by Leavenworth Co, said road
to be 20 feet wide in Douglas Co all on the west of above
described line, the east 20 feet of said road being now opened
by Leavenworth Co, and that said road be declared located
and established as a public highway in accordance therewith
full record thereof to be made in the County Road Record and plat
as road No. - and the Trustee of Grant Tract be notified to cause the same to be
opened for the public travel 20 feet wide.
