et al as recorded in Road Record Book 4
Page 161 being under consideration the
following action thereon was had by the Board
of Co Commissioners to wit: Upon due consideration
no legal objection being offered against the
establishment of the road herein after mentioned
and believing the same to be of public utility
it is ordered that the Views Report of View and
report and plat of Survey be adopted as follows
Beginning at the NE Cor of the E $\frac{1}{2}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 19 T13
R19 then N along $\frac{1}{2}$ Sec line 20 chains to the $\frac{1}{4}$ corner
on N line of said Sec 19 said road to be 20 feet
wide & all on the west side of the above described line
and that said road be declared & established
as a public highway in accordance therewith
full record thereof be made in Road Record Book 4
Page 161 and designated as Road 514 and
that the Trustee of Clinton Twp be notified to
cause the same to be opened for the Public travel
no damages allowed
