Bridge

} The following resolution was unanimously adopted. Whereas: The Kansas City, Topeka & Western Railroad Company a Corporation is desirous of raising the approach to the Bridge across the Kansas River at the North end of Mass Street on the South bank of the Kansas river in Lawrence Douglas Co Kansas according to a certain map or profile on file with the County Clerk of Douglas County, Kansas now therefore be it Resolved: that said Railroad Company be and it is hereby authorized and permission is granted to it its successors, assigns, and lessee to enter upon said bridge to raise the said bridge at the South end and the approach to the same not to exceed three feet above the grade now established as shown by the measurements found on the said profile & map. filed with said Co Clerk. All retaining walls & Piers to be completed in solid masonry and all expenses of every kind and character made necessary by these changes and the account of the work to be done and paid by said Railroad Company its successors & assigns. The said changes & all of said work to be done without necessary delay and without impeding unnecessarily public travel.
