The aforesaid petition of A. H. Vogl et al as recorded in Commissioners Record, G. Page 93 being under consideration the following action thereon was taken by the Board of Commissioners to wit: Upon due consideration no legal objection having been offered against the establishment of said road herein after mentioned and believing the same to be of public utility, it is ordered that the Viewers Report of view and report of plat and survey be adopted as follows, Beginning at the N. cor. on W. line of Sec 34 T 12 R 21 Var 845 east along $\frac{1}{2}$ sec line 4000 ch to centre of of sec Thence S 279 $\frac{1}{2}$ ch thence E 576 ch thence S 253 ch thence S 320 S' E 400 ch more or less to the centre of Public road running N. & S. along A. T. & S. Fe Ry said road to be 40 feet wide - 20 feet on either side of above described line. And that said road be declared, located and established as a public highway, in accordance thereof full record thereof to be run in the County Road Record and plat of road #516 and the Trustee of Eudora Twp be notified to cause the same to be opened to public travel 40 ft wide
