Hallmark et al as recorded in Commissioners Record '6' Page 111 being under consideration, no legal objections being made the following action thereon was had to wit: The Board believing the opening of said road to be of public utility ordered that the Viewers Report of View and Report and plat of Survey be adopted as follows: beginning at a point 1.57 ch South of the $\frac{1}{4}$ Cor on the W line of Sec 25 T 13 S R 17 E thence Var S 8° 45' E S 84° 45' E 4.07 ch thence S 8° 45' E 2.00 ch thence S 18° E 2.75 ch. S 4° E 8.00 more or less to intersect the old road running across the ford said road to be 60 feet wide from point of beginning 4.07 ch and 40 feet wide from this point to end of the above described line being the centre of said Road
