Two Hundred and Fifty \$250 dollars or as much as needed to paint the Bridge across the Kansas River at Eudora.

Proposition of
J. M. Newlin

The Board on motion ordered the Co Clerk to instruct the County Treasurer that John M. Newlin be allowed to redeem Ctl 123 sale of 1893 and the subsequent taxes of 1893-4-5 endorsed thereon for the sum of \$51.06, his offer being to that effect.

Tax Cancelled

That the Co Clerk instruct the Co Treasurer to cancel Ctl 563 sale of 1892 and the taxes of 1892-3-4 endorsed thereon said taxes being property of Lawrence University and is exempt from taxation
