

Lawrence Kansas January 9th 1897

In the Matter of a Road
Petitioned for by J. H. Glatthart et al

The aforesaid Petition of J. H. Glatthart et al as recorded in Commissioners Record 9 Page 121 being under consideration the following action was had thereon by the Board of Commissioners of Douglas Co Kas to wit: Upon due consideration, no legal objection having been offered against the establishment of said road hereinafter mentioned and believing the same to be of public utility it is ordered that the Viewers Report of Viewers Report and Plat of Survey be adopted as follows to wit: Beginning at the NW Corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 35 T12S R17E thence N $8^{\circ}45'$ E along the North line of said Sec 35. 20.00 ch to the NW cor Sec 36 thence E along the N line 40 ch more or less to the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec cor on north line of said Sec 36 thence S along the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec line 2.34 ch more or less to the South line of Winthrop & produced from the City of Lawrence said road to be 80 feet wide 40 feet on either side of above described line from the place of beginning to the NW cor of Sec 36 and 40 feet wide from this point to the end, all on the South & West of the above described line. and that said road be declared, located and established as a public highway in accordance thereof full record to be made in Road Record and Plat as Road * and the Trustee of Watkinson Township be notified to cause the same to be opened to public travel.

No Claim for damages presented.
